| <b>Job Title :</b>                       | Program Operations Volunteer  |
| <b>Objectives :</b>                      | Elephantstay has been operating since 2006 and although we have achieved a lot in this time we need enthusiastic qualified and committed people to move forward and achieve an even better life for elephants.<br>We are looking for people who want to be a real part of elephant conservation at its best.  |
| <b>Duties and Responsibilities :</b>     | You will be assisting with the people who participate in the Elephantstay program. You will have plenty of direct contact with the elephants. Duties include cleaning, feeding, diet preparation, etc of elephants. Our primary concern is the elephant's welfare and the safety of our participants. You may also be required to assist with the elephant painting project.  |

After that you will be under the supervision and training of the Operations Officer to perform duties as required.  |

| <b>Benefits :</b>                        | The work is free contact with elephants. At this stage we have eight elephants under our management, which will be the main elephants you will be getting to know and be working with. Depending on your length of stay and your progress there may be opportunities to assist with other elephants. We have about 80 elephants on site so you will have exposure and contact with many of them including baby elephants still with their mothers, and bull elephants. Elephantstay is situated in the heart of a working elephant village so there is also the advantage of learning about and interacting with people from another culture. |
| <b>Special Considerations :</b>          | Working with people and elephants in free contact can be a physically and mentally challenging experience. The work can be physically hard and the hours are long. Volunteers should be physically fit as well as be prepared to work in a hot tropical climate.  |
